Below we have created some questions to help us determine the best placement for the dog and create a low-stress transition. Please be honest with your answers, if you are not it could be detrimental to the dogs future, health and safety as well as those interacting with the dog. Please understand that Dalmatians, as any dog, usually arrive in rescue due to behaviour issues and/or health issues and that this is what you could be living with on a daily basis. We are here to help have the dog become a better canine citizen. Thank you for your co-operation.

1.	Do you have any prior experience with the Dalmatians? Please explain
2.	If no what breed/type of dogs were owned?
	Neutered / Spayed / Intact? Where are these dogs now?
3.	Are you familiar with the intelligence of the breed and the fact that they require a considerable amount of exercise as well as
	mental stimulation every day? (to a greater or lesser degree)
4.	What kind of exercise/training/dog sports do you or have you done with your dogs?
5.	Are you prepared for the care, training and exercise involved with a new dog for their life? (Including Veterinary costs, food,
	lifelong medications, professional training, etc that may be required)
6.	What kind of experience do you have with rehabilitation and/or retraining dogs?
7.	Are you willing to dedicate to life long vaccinations/titres, de-worming and flea regime as needed?
8.	Are you familiar with the concerns associated with HUA Dalmatians (Hyperuricosuria) / feeding a low purine diet and the extra cautions associated with male Dalmatians?
9.	Are you prepared to follow a feeding regime (if needed) that SSSDR/Veterinarians (Raw or Kibble low purine diet) advise?
10.	Will the dog be alone for any periods of time? If so, how long? Where will the dog stay/go?
11.	What if he/she if not crate trained? Are you willing to take the time/patience to do so?
12.	Are you prepared to deal with vices? Barking, digging, chewing, destructive behaviour, aggression, whining, etc?
13.	Are you prepared to deal with accidents? Urination, defecation, vomit, anal glands, blood, etc
14.	Are you prepared to ask SSSDR for advice or seek out professional help if required?
15.	Are there other animals in the home/property? If so how many and what types?
16.	How many people live in your household? What are their ages?
17.	Is everyone in the home in agreement getting a new dog? (if no please explain).
18.	Do you own the home you are in? Yes / No Are there stairs? Yes / No Type of flooring?
19.	Is it completely fenced? (for example 360 degrees, inescapable under/through/over). Yes / No Height?
